Presidential Election Management Regulations

<Amended on March 25, 2025>

Chapter 1. General Provisions

Article 1 (Purpose) These Regulations aim to set forth matters necessary for the election of Kukkiwon President in accordance with Article 10 Paragraph 9 of the Articles of Association of Kukkiwon (hereinafter, "President Election"). <Amended on December 9, 2020, and March 25, 2025>

Article 2 (Scope of Application) Matters relating to president election shall be governed by these Regulations, except those regulated by relevant laws and the Articles of Association, and if necessary detailed rules can be established, separately. Provided, however, that the president election is entrusted to the National Election Commission (hereinafter, the "National Election Commission") under the Election Commission Act, pursuant to Article 10 Paragraph 6 of the Articles of Association, the Act on Elections Entrusted by Public Organizations and Rules on Elections Entrusted by Public Organizations shall be applied in priority to the extent the election is president election of Kukkiwon. <Amended on December 9, and March 25, 2025>

Chapter 2. Establishment of Electoral Management Body, Etc.

Article 3 (Establishment of Election Management Committee, etc.) ① The Chairman of Kukkiwon (or acting Chairman; the same hereinafter) shall establish the Election Management Committee, a separate electoral management body, pursuant to Article 10 Paragraph 6 of the Articles of Association, not later than 120 days prior to the expiration of the presidential term. If the office of President is vacated or the President is unable to perform his or her duty, the Election Management Committee shall be constituted within 60 days from the date when the grounds for establishing the Committee are confirmed. Notwithstanding, in special circumstances such as natural disasters or an influx of infectious diseases, the

establishment may be past 60 days but not later than 180 days. The same rule shall be applied in the cases where re-election is to be held under Article 45 of these Regulations and Kukkiwon president election is entrusted to the National Election Commission pursuant to Article 10 Paragraph 6 of the Articles of Association. <Amended on December 9, 2020, and March 25, 2025>

② The Election Management Committee shall perform the duties in following subparagraphs. <Amended on March 25, 2025>

1. Selection of the electors;
2. Drawing up of the electors' register;
3. Handling of access to the electors' register and objections or appeal;
4. Matters relating to candidate registration, resignation, and public notice;
5. Suspension, warning, supervision and investigation of or about the election campaign and any violation therein;
6. Matters related to the holding of the policy debate;
7. Voting, counting, and determination of successful candidate;
8. Election guidance and promotion; and
9. Any other matters not prescribed herein or in the Articles of Association.

③ The Election Management Committee shall be dissolved within 60 days after the date of election, unless there are special circumstances in which case dissolution may be extended by the Chair. <Amended on December 9, 2020>

④ In these Regulations, the phrase "the day when the grounds for enforcement are confirmed" means the day when the President dies or cannot perform his duties due to reasons such as resignation or dismissal in accordance with the Articles of Association.

Article 4 (Entrustment of Election Affairs) ① In the case of entrusting the president election to the National Election Commission pursuant to Article 10 Paragraph 6 of the Articles of Association, a request shall be made to the National Election Commission in writing **【Form 1】** no later than 90 days prior to the expiration of the current presidential term (five (5) days from the date when the grounds for enforcement are confirmed in the case of re-election or the vacancy of presidential office or inability of the President to perform his or her duties due to accidents). Provided, however, in the case of unavoidable circumstances, the requesting period can be adjusted through consultation with the National Election Commission. <Amended on December 9, 2020, and March 25, 2025>

② The scope of election entrustment under Paragraph 1 shall be as the following subparagraphs.

1. Affairs relating to the candidate registration (except the affairs relating to electors selection);
2. Affairs relating to voting;
3. Affairs relating to ballot count (including affairs relating to the determination

of successful candidate);

4. Election guidance and promotion; and

5. Supervision and investigation on the election campaign conducted in violation of the laws, the Articles of Association of Kukkiwon, or these Regulations.

③ In the case of entrusting the president election to the National Election Commission pursuant to Paragraph 1, the Committee shall discuss the scope of entrustment with the Commission and execute a written agreement with the Commission. <Amended on December 9, 2020>

Article 5 (Composition of the Election Management Committee) ① The Election Management Committee shall be composed of seven (7) to nine (9) members, and the majority of the members shall be outsiders, such as persons from academic, media or legal circles who have no interests with Kukkiwon. <Amended on December 9, 2020>

② Outsiders who have no interests with Kukkiwon referred to in Paragraph 1 mean those who are not an incumbent executives or employee of Kukkiwon in the year when the Election Management Committee is constituted, and who have not been designated, appointed, or selected by the Chair or President and do not stay on the position. <Amended on December 9, 2020, and March 25, 2025>

③ The members of Election Management Committee shall be appointed by the Chairman through the consent of the Board of Directors. Provided, however, if the office of Chairman is vacated or the Chairman is unable to perform his or her duties due to accidents, the acting Chairman pursuant to Article 16 of the Articles of Association shall appoint the members with the consent of the Board of Directors. In the case where the acting Chairman is the President, the Board of Directors shall take the role of composing and appointing members of the Election Management Committee. <Amended on December 9, 2020, May 27, 2022, and March 25, 2025>

④ The Committee can appoint the members by receiving the recommendation from the National Election Commission.

⑤ Kukkiwon directors and employees shall not be the members of Election Management Committee.

⑥ The chair of the Election Management Committee shall be designated by the Chairman from among the members of the Election management Committee. <Amended on May 27, 2022>

⑦ One (1) secretary of the Election Management Committee shall be appointed by the Chairman and may be paid daily expenses. <Amended on May 27, 2022, and March 25, 2025>

⑧ The Committee can have a number of administrative assistants for composition and management of electors, and may pay them daily expenses. <Newly inserted on May 27, 2022><Amended on March 25, 2025>

⑨ Any person who is appointed as the member of Election Management Committee shall not be the candidate or elector for the office of President and cannot participate in the election campaign thereof. <Amended on March 25, 2025>

Article 6 (Duties of the Committee Members) ① The chair of the Election Management Committee shall represent the Election Management Committee and supervise the work thereof.

② The members of the Election Management Committee shall compose the Committee, and attend the Committee to deliberate and resolve matters relating to the Committee duties.

③ In the case that the chair cannot perform his or her duties due to unavoidable reasons, a senior member among the members shall perform the duty for the chair.

Article 7 (Grounds for Disqualification) ① Any person who falls under the grounds prescribed in Article 12 of the Articles of Association of Kukkiwon shall not be the member of Election Management Committee. <Amended on December 9, 2020, and March 25, 2025>

② Any member who becomes to meet the Paragraph 1 condition or is revealed to meet the Paragraph 1 condition at the time of appointment, the member will be dismissed, as a matter of course. <Amended on March 25, 2025>

Article 8 (Term of the Committee Members) The term of the members of Election Management Committee shall be from the date of appointment to the dissolution of the Committee.

Article 9 (Convocation of the Committee, etc) ① The Committee shall be convened by the chair, when necessary.

② If the chair does not convene the Committee without a justifiable reason, it can be convened with the approval of the majority of the registered members.

③ The Committee shall be begun with the majority attendance of the registered members, and the resolutions shall be passed by the approval of the majority of the members present at the meeting, unless prescribed otherwise in the Articles of Association or these Regulations. <Amended on March 25, 2025>

Article 10 (Disclosure of the Matters Relating to the Committee, etc.) ① The Committee meetings shall be kept in confidence in order to ensure fairness in its deliberation and resolution.

② The members of Election Management Committee shall keep in confidence all

information which they acquire during the election management course, such as information about the presidential candidates and the electors, their private life, and the contents of screening and deliberation, and shall not divulge such information to outsiders.

③ The members of Election Management Committee shall submit the declaration of confidentiality, etc. to Kukkiwon. <Amended on December 9, 2020, and March 25, 2025>

④ The Election Management Committee shall draw up and retain the minutes which record the contents of deliberation and resolution made at the meetings, and upon dissolution it shall hand over all documents and papers which it has created and retained to Kukkiwon. <Amended on March 25, 2025>

Article 11 (Exclusion and Recusal, etc.) ① The chair and the committee members shall not participate in the deliberation and resolution of the Election Management Committee if they meet any of the following subparagraphs. <Amended on March 25, 2025>

1. If that they have a familial relation (as described in Article 777 of the Civil Act) with the candidate for Kukkiwon President; or
2. If there is a justifiable reason that cannot ensure fairness in the election process

② If a member falls under either of the cases in Paragraph 1, the member may reveal the situation voluntarily, in writing, and request to recuse him/herself from the screening or deliberation meetings for relevant candidate or withdraw from such process.

Article 12 (Dismissal of Committee Members) If a Committee member falls under any of the following conditions, the Chairman may dismiss the member except subparagraphs 4 through 6, in which case the Chairman is obliged to dismiss the member from the Committee. <Amended on December 9, 2020>

1. If the member has committed misconduct related to the member's duties;
2. If the member is objectively acknowledged to be unfit for the Committee due to neglect of duty, injury to dignity, illness, or other reasons;
3. If the member is deemed to be unfit to perform the member's duties because of his or her action that degrades the dignity of the Committee members, such as violation of the positive law;
4. Non-compliance with Article 10 Paragraph 2;
5. Voluntary resignation; and
6. Failing to recuse or withdraw despite the fact that his or her condition meets the cases prescribed in Article 11.

Article 13 (Payment of Expenses) ① The members of Election Management

Committee may be paid allowance for attending the Committee as described in **【Appendix】**. <Amended on December 9, 2020>

② The chair and the members of the Committee shall not be paid for any other expenses than the attendance allowance, except the minimum actual expenses necessary for them to perform their work.

③ Despite Paragraph 2, the chair and the secretary can be paid daily expenses if they go to work for the operation of the Election Management Committee.

④ In the case that daily expenses are paid under Paragraph 3, any other expenses including the attendance allowance shall not be paid.

⑤ Attendance allowance shall not be paid in the case where the meetings under Article 9 have not been held.

Chapter 3. Composition of Electors, Etc.

<Amended on March 25, 2025>

Article 14 (Electors) ① The electors, a body of presidential election pursuant to Article 10 Paragraph 5 of the Articles of Association, shall be composed as follows. <Amended on December 9, 2020, and May 27, 2022>

1. The president of the World Taekwondo or one (1) executive appointed by the president;

2. The president of the Korea Taekwondo Association, or one (1) executive appointed by the president;

3. The chairman of the Taekwondo Promotion Foundation, or one (1) executive appointed by the chairman;

4. The chief or head of Taekwondo organizations in the cities or provinces in Korea, that are affiliated with the Korea Taekwondo Association;

5. Total five (5) presidents of each of the five (5) Continental Unions, or five (5) executives appointed by each of the five (5) presidents themselves;

6. The president of the 9th Dan Association, or one (1) executive appointed by the president him/herself;

7. The president of the Korea Para Taekwondo Association, or one (1) executive appointed by the president;

8. The president of the Korea Women Taekwondo Federation, or one (1) executive appointed by the president (The person shall be female);

9. From among the national Taekwondo associations of each continent that have greatly contributed to the development of Kukkiwon (based on three (3) years' average contribution in Poom and Dan tests of Kukkiwon), twenty (20) persons from Asia, Europe, Pan-America, Africa, and Oceania;

10. One (1) representative of the employees of Kukkiwon;
 11. One (1) Kukkiwon Taekwondo master dispatched overseas; and
 12. A person randomly selected from each 20% of Taekwondo masters who are registered at Kukkiwon information system (KPS and KMS), and who have not only the right of recommendation either inside or outside of Korea but also the actual record of recommendation for the last two (2) years (excluding persons falling under subparagraphs 1 through 11 above).
- ② Electors shall be 19 years of age or older (including from those who were born in the same year as the persons who become 19 years old).
 - ③ "The level of contribution to the development of Kukkiwon (three (3) years' average contribution in Poom and Dan tests of Kukkiwon)" referred to in Paragraph 1 Subparagraph 9 above means the average number of applicants who made recommendation for the Poom and Dan tests of Kukkiwon during three (3) years immediately preceding the year when the president election takes place.
 - ④ "The last two (2) years" referred to in Paragraph 1 Subparagraph 12 shall be based on December 31 of the year preceding the year in which the president election takes place.
 - ⑤ Persons in Paragraph 1 Subparagraphs 11 and 12 shall have the International Taekwondo Master Certificate issued by Kukkiwon. However, foreigners who have the examination recommendation right shall be exceptional.
 - ⑥ The electors shall be organized not later than 90 days prior to the expiration of the term of the President pursuant to Article 10 Paragraph 4 of the Articles of Association. Provided, however, if the election is due to the vacancy or inability to perform duties of the President, the electors shall be organized in consideration of schedule after the establishment of the Election Management Committee in Article 3. <Amended on December 9, 2020>

Article 14-2 (Selection of Electors) ① Persons in each subparagraph of Article 14 Paragraph 1 shall not be overlapping with persons in other subparagraphs in Paragraph 1.

② Electors in Subparagraphs 9 through 12 of Article 14 Paragraph 1 shall be selected by the Election Management Committee as follows, based on the materials provided by the administrative office of Kukkiwon:

1. Persons in Article 14 Paragraph 1 Subparagraph 9 shall be total 20, including the national presidents of five (5) Continental Unions in Asia, Europe, Pan-America, Africa and Oceania who are granted by Kukkiwon the right to recommend the examination, or masters designated by those presidents (persons who hold International Taekwondo Master Certificate issued by Kukkiwon). The number of electors from five (5) Continental Unions shall be allocated by the continent as six (6) in Asia, six (6) in Europe, four (4) in Pan-America, two (2) in Africa and two

(2) in Oceania. However, the Republic of Korea is excluded in this allocation.

2. As for the persons of the national associations referred to in Article 14 Paragraph 1 Subparagraph 9 and the persons with the right to recommend examination in Subparagraph 12, their right to recommend examination shall be valid at the time of organizing the electors.

3. Article 14 Paragraph 1 Subparagraph 10 shall be applied only to the full-time employees of Kukkiwon, of whom one (1) person shall be selected through voting.

4. Article 14 Paragraph 1 Subparagraph 11 shall be applied to Taekwondo masters who have been dispatched overseas for not less than two (2) years by Kukkiwon, and of those masters one (1) shall be selected by lot.

5. Persons referred to in Article 14 Paragraph 1 Subparagraph 12 shall be randomly selected of each 20% among those who have the right to recommend examination either inside or outside of Korea and have the record of actual recommendation for the last two (2) years registered at Kukkiwon information system (KPS and KMS) in accordance with the criteria prescribed in Article 14 Paragraph 4, after excluding the electors falling under Paragraph 1 Subparagraphs 1 through 11. However, below decimal point shall be disregarded.

③ In the case of overlapping recommendation of a elector, the Election Management Committee shall follow the rules in each subparagraph.

1. In the case of overlapping recommendation by the organizations referred to in Article 14 Paragraph 1 Subparagraphs 1 through 9, the Committee shall decide, based on the recommendee's own opinion, from which organization the elector is recommended, and then shall request other organizations to change their original nominee and recommend another person, instead.

2. If the recommendee by the organizations prescribed in Article 14 Paragraph 1 Subparagraphs 1 through 9 and the recommendee under Subparagraph 11 are overlapped, person recommended by an organization shall take priority, and re-selection shall be done in accordance with Paragraph 2 Subparagraph 4.

④ The recommendation and selection under Article 14 Paragraph 1 Subparagraphs 1 through 12 shall be done only once, and no re-recommendation or re-selection shall be required. However, each case of Paragraph 3 shall be considered as an exception.

Article 15 (Request for Electors Recommendation) ① To constitute the electors in accordance with Article 14 Paragraph 1 Subparagraphs 1 through 8, the Election Management Committee shall request relevant organizations to recommend the electors within 14 day-response period. <Amended on December 9, 2020, and March 25, 2025>

② To constitute the electors in accordance with Article 14 Paragraph 1 Subparagraphs 9 through 12, the Election Management Committee shall request

relevant department of Kukkiwon to provide related materials. <Amended on December 9, 2020, May 27, 2022, and March 25, 2025>

③ In the case of Article 14 Paragraph 1 Subparagraph 9, once the national association is determined based on the materials under Subparagraph 2, the Election Management Committee shall make the same request as Paragraph 1. <Amended on December 9, 2020>

④ If any organization under Article 14 Paragraph 1 Subparagraphs 1 through 9 fails to recommend the **electors** by the deadline set by the Election Management Committee, the Committee will not allocate the **electors** to such organization. <Newly inserted on March 25, 2025>

Article 16 (Preparation of Electors' Register) ① The Election Management Committee shall draw up the electors' register **【Form 2】** for three (3) days 17 days prior to the date of election based on the list of voting recommendee received in accordance with Article 15. In doing so, the Committee shall check if there is any overlapping and verify their qualification in accordance with Article 14 and 14-2.

② Electors shall submit the Consent to Collect, Use, and Provide Personal Information to Third Parties **【Form 3】**. The form may be different if using the Kukkiwon information system.

③ The final list of electors named in the electors' register shall not be changed or replaced.

④ If the telephone number or email account of the electors do not fit to online voting, the Election Management Committee shall notify the electors to correct the matter before the date when the electors' register is finalized so that the matter will not affect the voting. Provided, however, that the electors do not correct the matter before the deadline, the Committee shall finalize the electors' register as it is, to which no person, including relevant electors, shall not raise objections at any time. <Newly inserted on August 18, 2022>

[Entire amendment on March 25, 2025]

Article 17 (Access to the Electors' Register, etc.) ① The Election Management Committee shall ensure that the electors can access and review the electors' register at a place designated by the committee pursuant to Article 16.

② The access and review period of the electors' register shall be three (3) days from the following day when the electors' register is drawn up completely and to one day before the electors' register is finalized.

③ The electors' register shall be finalized and confirmed no later than 11 days prior to the election day.

④ If it is accepted that there is an omission or disqualified elector in the electors' register, relevant elector can raise objections to the Election Management Committee, verbally or in writing, during the access and review period.

⑤ In the case of receiving objections referred to in Paragraph 4, the Election Management Committee shall deliberate and determine the matter not later than the next day, and if the Committee determines that the objections are acceptable, it shall correct the electors' register immediately and notify relevant organization, applicant(s), and concerned parties which fall under Article 14 Paragraph 1 Subparagraphs 1 through 12. If the Committee determines the objections are not acceptable, it shall notify the applicant(s) of the reasons. <Amended on December 9, 2020>

⑥ The candidates can request the copy of the electors' register during the candidate registration application period. Upon receipt such request, the Election Management Committee shall issue the copy of electors' register by the opening day of the election.

⑦ The candidates shall not assign or lend the copy of electors' register it received under Paragraph 6 above to any person other than the election officials and clerks, nor use it for other purposes than the purposes of the election. <Newly inserted on August 18, 2022> <Amended on March 25, 2025>

⑧ If a candidate's violation of Paragraph 7 is revealed, the Committee can sanction the candidate in accordance with Articles 28 and 47. <Newly inserted on March 25, 2025>

Chapter 4. Eligibility and Registration of Candidates

Article 18 (Eligibility) ① Candidates for President shall be a holder of the Kukkiwon Taekwondo 6th Dan or higher as of the opening date of candidate registration pursuant to Article 10 Paragraph 1 of the Articles of Association. <Amended on December 9, 2020, August 18, 2022 and March 25, 2025>

② As of the opening date of candidate registration, any person who falls under the disqualification grounds in Article 12 of the Articles of Association of Kukkiwon cannot be the candidate. <Amended on December 9, 2020, August 18, 2022 and March 25, 2025>

③ If an executive or employee of Kukkiwon, World Taekwondo, Korea Taekwondo Association, Taekwondo Promotion Foundation, Taekwondo 9th Dan Association, Korea Para Taekwondo Association, Korea Women Taekwondo Federation and any affiliated entities thereof intends to register as a candidate, he or she shall resign (withdraw) from relevant organization not later than 90 days before the expiration of the term of the President. Provided, however, that such persons are registered as a candidate for the election which is held because of the vacancy or inability of the presidential office, they shall resign (withdraw) from relevant organization within ten (10) days from the day when the grounds for election are confirmed, unless the establishment of the Election Management Committee is delayed due to special circumstances such

as natural disasters or an influx of infectious diseases. In the later case, the prospective candidates shall resign (withdraw) from relevant organization within ten (10) days from the date designated by the Election Management Committee. <Amended on December 9, 2020, May 27, 2022, and March 25, 2025>

④ In the case where the incumbent President of Kukkiwon resigns in order to register him/herself as a candidate for President, the president election in such case will be deemed to be held due to the expiration of the presidential term. <Newly inserted on August 18, 2022>

Article 19 (Trust Money) ① Anyone who intends to apply for candidate registration shall pay trust money in the amount of 50 million KRW to the Election Management Committee (National Election Commission) at the time of submitting the registration application. <Amended on May 27, 2022>

② The payment of trust money shall be made in Korean Won (KRW), and be deposited in the applicant's name to the savings account of financial institutions (including post office) opened by the Election Management Committee (National Election Commission) for this purpose. Once the deposit is completed, the candidate shall submit the deposit receipt issued by the financial institution to the Election Management Committee. Notwithstanding, cash payment (including cashier's check issued by a financial institution) may be accepted if there is an unavoidable reason.

③ In the case where the Election Management Committee receives the trust money in cash under the condition permitted by Paragraph 2, it shall issue the receipt to the payer and deposit the cash to relevant financial institution, immediately.

Article 20 (Announcement of Candidate Recruitment) ① The Election Management Committee (National Election Commission) shall publish the recruitment notice including the candidate registration period to the Kukkiwon website, etc. for at least 14 days from 25 days prior to the date of election until one day before the first date of candidate registration.

② When the Election Management Committee (National Election Commission) makes notice under Paragraph 1, it shall also state the reasons of disqualification of executives as prescribed by the Articles of Association of Kukkiwon.

Article 21 (Candidate Registration, etc.) ① Anyone who intends to become a candidate shall apply for the candidate registration to the Election Management Committee (National Election Commission), in writing, by him/herself or through a proxy with a power of attorney for two (2) days from two (2) days prior to the opening of the election period (or for two (2) days after the last day of

announcement). In this case, the receipt of the application for candidate registration shall begin at 9:00 AM to 6:00 PM in local time of Kukkiwon, everyday regardless of holidays.

② Anyone who applies for candidate registration shall submit the documents, etc. in each of the following subparagraphs, and especially the documents prescribed in Subparagraphs 2 and 3 shall be issued after the date of announcement concerning the candidate recruitment in accordance with Article 20. In the case of documents made in foreign languages, the Korean translation shall be attached thereto. <Amended on May 27, 2022, August 18, 2022 and April 30, 2025>

1. Application for presidential candidate registration **【Form 4】**

2. Certificate of driver's license

3. In case of an applicant who used to be affiliated with a sports or Taekwondo organization (applicable only to the sports and Taekwondo organizations and groups prescribed in Article 12 of the Articles of Association. Hereinafter the same applies), a document issued or filled either by such sports or Taekwondo organization **【Form 5】** or by an organization which establishes an integrated disciplinary information system in accordance with the National Sports Promotion Act, to verify whether the applicant has received disciplinary actions (only if applicable).

4. Confirmation of no affiliation **【Form 6】**, in the case of a candidate who has no record of affiliation with a sports or Taekwondo organization (only if applicable)

5. Confirmation of no grounds for disqualification of executives **【Form 7】**

6. Trust money in accordance with Article 19 or any documents that can verify the payment of trust money

7. Certificate of resignation (withdrawal) (only if the candidate was an executive pursuant to Article 18, Paragraph 3)

8. Consent to Collect, Use, and Provide Personal Information to Third Parties **【Form 8】**

9. Any other documents designated by the Election Management Committee (National Election Commission)

③ The Election Management Committee (National Election Commission) shall accept the application of candidate registration immediately upon the receipt of the application. Provided, however, that the application is not complete due to a lack of required documents prescribed in Paragraph 2 Subparagraphs 1 through 8 (except the documents only required for applicants under Subparagraph 3 and 4), the Committee shall not accept the application.

④ The Election Management Committee (National Election Commission) has the right to request relevant institutions to investigate matters relating to the eligibility of candidates, such as criminal records, after the close of the candidate registration, to which the candidates shall cooperate fully.

⑤ The Election Management Committee (National Election Commission) shall nullify the registration of any candidate, if the candidate has the reasons

prescribed in any of the following subparagraphs. <Amended on August 18, 2022>

1. If the candidate is found to be not eligible to run for the election;
 2. If the candidate fails to submit any documents prescribed in Paragraph 2 Subparagraphs 1 through 8 or the information submitted is found to be false or untruthful; and
 3. If the candidate is found to be disqualified under Article 18.
- ⑥ When the Election Management Committee (National Election Commission) nullifies the candidate registration, it shall give notice to the candidate with description of the reasons, immediately.
- ⑦ The candidate number for the purpose of posting the names of the candidates, etc. shall be determined by lot on the closing date of registration. Either the candidates themselves or their proxies with a proper power of attorney can draw lots. If, however, neither the candidates nor their proxies are present, the Election Management Committee (National Election Commission) may draw lots for them.
- ⑧ The documents received by the Election Management Committee (National Election Commission) under Subparagraph 2, etc. will not be returned to the candidate/applicants.

[Entire amendment on March 25, 2025]

- Article 22 (Declaration of Candidate Resignation, etc.)** ① In the case where a candidate intends to resign, the candidate him/herself shall visit the Election Management Committee (National Election Commission) in person **【Form 9】** and report to the Committee. <Amended on August 18, 2022, and March 25, 2025>
- ② The Election Management Committee (National Election Commission) shall announce the registration (finalized), resignation, death, or registration nullification of candidates on its website immediately if and when it confirms the event.

Chapter 5. Election and Election Campaign

- Article 23 (Election Period and Date of Election)** ① "Election period" refers to ten (10) day-period from the next day of the closing of candidate registration and to the election day.
- ② The Election Management Committee (National Election Commission) shall hold the president election in accordance with Article 10 of the Articles of Association, set the election date no later than 25 days prior to the election day, and announce it on the Kukkiwon website, etc. <Amended on December 9, 2020, and March 25, 2025>

Article 24 (Definition of Election Campaign) Election campaigns mean an action performed in order to make oneself or a specific person be elected or not be elected. Nevertheless, an action described in any of the following subparagraphs shall not be regarded as an election campaign.

1. Simply presentation or expression of opinions about the election;
2. Preliminary action or preparation for potential candidates and election campaign; and
3. Normal and regular business activity

Article 25 (Main Agent and Method of Election Campaign) ① The candidates can run an election campaign only in the manners prescribed in the following subparagraphs. <Amended on May 27, 2022 and August 18, 2022>

1. Direct communication between the candidate and electors via telephone;
2. Sending text messages (including image, voice, picture, and video, etc.) to electors;
3. Using information network system (e-mail and SNS, etc.);
4. Giving out the candidates' business cards (9 x 5 cm or less in size) and asking for support;
5. Introducing the candidates and their policy on the election day (in case of online voting, pre-recorded video to be posted on the Kukkiwon website); and
6. Attending the policy debate held by the Election Management Committee.

② The election campaign for policy introduction under Paragraph 1 Subparagraph 5 shall be as follows. <Amended on May 27, 2022>

1. The chair of the Election Management Committee shall introduce each candidate in accordance with the candidate number at the polling station or the place where the Board of Director meeting is held before the voting begins, and have the candidates present their point of views. In this case, the presentation time shall be given to the candidates equality within ten (10) minutes for each.
2. If a candidate does not arrive at the polling station, etc. by his/her presentation time, the candidate shall be deemed to have waived it.
3. The chair of the Election Management Committee shall stop the candidate if the candidate speaks or makes a remark in violation of these Regulations. Further, if the candidate disobeys, the chair shall take necessary actions, such as suspending his or her presentation, etc.
4. The chair of the Election Management Committee shall stop anyone who interferes with the candidates' presentation of their viewpoints or disturbs peace and order in the polling station, and can further have the person removed from the polling station, etc. if the person does not comply with the order.

5. Carrying or bring any markers that show the candidates' symbol, photo, and/or name into the presentation place are strictly prohibited.
- ③ The length of pre-recorded video to be used at the presentation referred to in Paragraph 1 Subparagraph 5 shall be maximum ten (10) minutes. The candidate shall submit the pre-recorded video, a letter of self-introduction and **【Form 10】** to the Election Management Committee within four (4) days from the last day of candidate registration, and the Committee shall post the candidate's video and self-introduction letter on the Kukkiwon website from the next day of the submission deadline to the election day. Nonetheless, any pre-recorded video received after the set submission deadline shall be posted immediately.
- ④ The election campaign in accordance with policy debate referred to in Paragraph 1 Subparagraph 6 shall be as follows.
1. The Election Management Committee shall hold a policy debate for the candidates once. However, if there is only one (1) candidate, the policy debate will not be held.
 2. The Election Management Committee shall set and notify the candidates of the time, date and place of the policy debate.
 3. The candidates who receive the notice in Subparagraph 2 shall submit either the confirmation of attendance **【Form 11】** or the reasons for non-attendance **【Form 12】** not later than three (3) days prior to the date of policy debate.
 4. If a candidate fails to submit the confirmation of attendance referred to in Subparagraph 3, the candidate will be regarded to have given up the attendance. If a candidate has submitted the confirmation of attendance but does not attend the debate, the candidate shall submit the reason for non-attendance by the next day of the policy debate.
 5. The Election Management Committee shall ensure that the host of the policy debate is a fair person.
 6. The policy debate shall be carried out as a question and answer format between the host and the candidates, and a question and answer format among the candidates themselves. Details of the policy details shall be determined by the Election Management Committee.
 7. The Election Management Committee shall give all candidates a fair and equal opportunity to participate in the debate, and the host shall allot the number and time of question and answer to all candidates, equally and evenly.
 8. Any persons other than the candidates can not participate in the debate as a debater.
 9. The Election Management Committee shall broadcast the policy debate live in real time and publish the recording on the Kukkiwon website.

- ⑤ The election office clerks shall be allowed to run the election campaign only in the manners prescribed in Paragraph 1 Subparagraphs 1 through 4.
- ⑥ No persons other than the candidates, and election office clerks shall be allowed to run the election campaign.
- ⑦ False or untruthful information about the candidates' education and/or career records shall not be used for election campaign.
- ⑧ Details concerning the election campaign method under Paragraph 1 shall be in compliance with the manners determined by the Election Management Committee (National Election Commission).

[Entire amendment on March 25, 2025]

Article 26 (Period of Election Campaign) The period of election campaign shall be limited to the preceding day of the election day from the next day of the registration deadline. However, the case that the candidate presents his or her viewpoints on the day of election shall be accepted as an exception.

Article 27 (Restriction on Election Campaign) ① No person shall act or commit an action as described in any of the following subparagraphs in order to ensure oneself or a certain candidate will be elected or not be elected.

1. Providing the electors (including those eligible for electors before the electors' register is drawn up) or the electors' family (meaning, the spouses of the electors, the linear ascendants and descendants of the electors and their spouses, and the spouses of the linear ascendants and descendants of the electors and of their siblings; hereinafter the same rule to be applied), or the institute, organization, or entity established and/or operated by the electors or their family money, goods, treats and/or financial interest, or a position at a public or private organization, or expressing the intention to provide such or promising to provide such;
2. Committing an action as prescribed in Subparagraph 1 to a candidate or prospective candidate in order to make the person not become a candidate or make the person resign from the candidacy, etc.;
3. Accepting interest or a position prescribed in Subparagraphs 1 or 2, or allowing the expression of offering such; and
4. Making a direction, recommendation, arrangement, or demand concerning the acts prescribed in Subparagraphs 1 through 3.

② No person shall visit the electors individually, or have the electors gathering at a certain place for election campaign.

③ No person shall slander or defaming the candidates in relation with the president election, by announcing falsity or stating the facts expressively about the

candidates by means of telephone, text message, information network system, business card, or any other methods. <Amended on March 25, 2025>

④ One (1) election office shall be allowed for each candidate with maximum five (5) election office clerks therein. Notwithstanding, the executives and employees under Article 18 Paragraph 3 shall not be the election office clerk. <Amended on May 27, 2022, August 18, 2022, and March 25, 2025>

⑤ The candidates shall report to the Election Management Committee by using the 【Form 13 and 14】 when they set up the election office and hire election office clerks. <Newly inserted on May 27, 2022> <Amended on August 18, 2022, and March 25, 2025>

⑥ All costs and expenses relating to the election offices shall be borne by relevant candidates, and the candidates may pay the office clerks an allowance and actual expenses. The allowance for the election office clerks shall not exceed one hundred thousand (100,000) KRW per day, and the actual expense will be as prescribed in Appendix 2 Paragraph 2 of the Regulations on Public Officials' Travel Expenses. <Newly inserted on May 27, 2022; Amended on August 18, 2022>

Article 28 (Penalty) ① The Election Management Committee shall have the right to sanction any person who is found to have committed a prohibited action in the Articles of Association and/or these Regulations in relation to the president election, by the manner as follows. <Amended on May 27, 2022, and March 25, 2025>

1. In the cases where the violation is deemed to harm the fairness in the election seriously, or the Committee's suspension order, warning, or correction order has not been followed:

- A. Nullification of the candidate registration or invalidation of election (applicable only to the candidates);
- B. Depriving the elector of the voting right;
- C. Disqualifying the election office clerks;
- D. Requesting Kukkiwon Reward and Punishment Committee or relevant organization of the violater to punish the person;
- E. Restriction on the violater's future application for or participation in all events, projects, qualification or license tests relating to Kukkiwon, and restriction on his or her employment or service at any Taekwondo organizations as an executive or employee (applicable only to the persons who are not affiliated in Taekwondo organizations);
- F. Suspension of licenses or qualifications, such as Poon and Dan of Kukkiwon,

mater, referee, or jury or judge license, expulsion from the licensee lists of the foregoing positions, or restriction on the issuance of various certificates; and

G. Requesting investigation on the violater or reporting the violater to an investigation agency of competent jurisdiction.

H. Sanctions in the same paragraph and subparagraph can be applied concurrently.

2. In the cases where the violation is deemed to have harmed the fairness in the election, lightly.

A. Request to cease, give a warning against, or order to correct the violation, verbally or in writing (Only the first time);

B. Notice to the electors about the occurrence of violation and related sanctions; and

C. Posting the fact of violation and details of sanction on the election day at each polling station (Kukkiwon website in case of online voting).

D. Sanctions in the same paragraph and subparagraph can be applied concurrently.

② In the cases where the declaration under Article 21 Paragraph 2 Subparagraph 5 (Confirmation of non-existence of disqualification grounds of executives) is found to be false, relevant candidate shall be expelled from the eligible group for election permanently, and if the violater is the person winning the election, the election shall be canceled.

Article 29 (Constitution of the Fair Election Support Team) ① The Election Management Committee (National Election Commission) may establish the Fair Election Support Team comprised of neutral and fair people in order to prevent, monitor, and check any violation in the president election.

② The number of the members of the Fair Election Support Team shall not exceed ten (10), and they can be paid allowance and actual expenses. <Amended on May 27, 2022>

Article 30 (Neutral Duty of the Kukkiwon Members in Election) ① The executives and employees of Kukkiwon (including the persons under Chapters 6 through 9 of the Articles of Association of Kukkiwon; hereinafter the same in this article) shall have the duty of neutrality in election. Provided, however, that the employees of Kukkiwon perform the service of secretary or administrative assistant for smooth process of the president election procedure, their service shall not be regarded as the violation of neutral duty. <Amended on May 27, 2022, August 18, 2022, and March 25, 2025>

② In the cases where an executive or employee of Kukkiwon divulges the information concerning the composition of the electors without the approval of the Election Management Committee (National Election Commission), or commits a similar violation equivalent to such illegal disclosure, the Committee can demand the Reward and Punishment Committee of Kukkiwon (Sanction Committee) to investigate the matter and sanction the violater. The Committee can also report the violater to a judicial institution but in this case there must be sufficient evidence about the wrongdoing. <Amended on December 9, 2020, and March 25, 2025>

[Title amended on March 25, 2025]

Article 31 (Election Method, etc.) ① The election shall be secret vote using ballot.

② The voting shall be carried out in the manner that the electors fill in a ballot directly (including the online voting). <Amended on December 9, 2020>

③ Each elector shall have one (1) vote.

④ No mark or sign shall be made on the ballot which enables others to presume the name of the electors or other persons.

⑤ The Election Management Committee (National Election Commission) shall issue the ballot only after it verifies the electors' identity through their photo ID (resident registration card, passport, drivers' license, public official card, etc.). In the case of online voting, however, the verification of elector identity can be carried out by the method set by the Election Management Committee (National Election Commission). <Amended on August 18, 2022, and March 25, 2025>

Article 31-2 (Judgment of Voting, etc.) ① Ballots that fall in any of the following subparagraphs shall not be nullified.

1. ㊦ sign is displayed only partially or inside of ㊦ sign is filled, but it is clear that the elector has filled in the ballot by using the balloting tool provided by the Election Management Committee (National Election Commission);

2. Twice or more markings in one candidate;

3. Extra marking in the ballot other than in the candidate columns, but such extra marking cannot be recognized as it has not been marked on any of the candidates;

4. The marking is smeared or transferred to outside of the candidate column but it is clear that to which candidate the elector casts the vote; or

5. Although the ballot is stained, spoiled, or damaged by human flesh, it is clear that the ballot is the regular and official ballot of the Committee and which candidate the elector has chosen.

- ② Voting shall be nullified in the cases of any of the following subparagraphs.
1. Using non-regular or official ballot paper;
 2. No marking in any of the boxes;
 3. Marking across two boxes or marking in two or more separate boxes;
 4. Marking that makes it impossible to recognize in which boxes the elector marks;
 5. Not ⊕ sign but a letter or image is entered;
 6. Not ⊕ sign but different form is marked; and
 7. Marking done by a tool which is not the official marking tool provided by the Election Management Committee (National Election Commission)
- ③ Online voting shall follow the Online Voting Regulations.
[Article newly inserted on March 25, 2025]

Article 32 (Installation of Polling Station) The Election Management Committee (National Election Commission) shall install the polling station before the preceding day of the election day, unless the election is carried out online.
<Amended on May 27, 2022>

Article 33 (Ballot) ① In the ballot, the symbol and name of the candidate shall be marked. The symbol of the candidates shall be displayed in accordance with the order of posting, such as "1, 2, 3" and their names shall be written in both Korean and English languages. If two more candidates have a same name, the date of birth of each candidate shall be displayed in brackets. <Amended on March 25, 2025>

② If there is only one (1) candidate, notwithstanding Paragraph 1 above, the candidate's name shall be written in the ballot and the ballot is formed in such a manner that the electors can express their agreement or disagreement to the election of the candidate as the President.

Article 34 (Voting Time) ① The time of voting shall be determined by the Election Management Committee (National Election Commission).

② Upon closing the voting, electors who are waiting in the polling station to vote shall be given number ticket to complete their vote before closing (applicable only to the polling station in Korea). <Amended on December 9, 2020>

Article 35 (Sending of the Voting Guidance) ① The Election Management Committee (National Election Commission) shall send the electors the voting guidance brochure which states the name and registration number of the elector, location of the polling

station, time of voting, items to be brought to the polling station, voting procedure, and remarks of promotion to participate in the voting, etc. within two (2) days after the confirmation of the electors' register.

② The Election Management Committee (National Election Commission) may send out the voting guidance to the electors via text messages or email, etc. and the guidance can be prepared in English. <Amended on December 9, 2020, and May 27, 2022>

Article 36 (Online Voting) ① Voting can be carried out by internet-based personal computers and mobile communication device (smartphone and tablet PC, etc.) (hereinafter, "online voting"). Details on the online voting shall be specified in separate regulations and be approved by the Board of Directors. <Amended on December 9, 2020, May 27, 2022, and March 25, 2025>

② In the case of online voting in accordance with Paragraph 1, the notice of online voting and the period of online voting shall be announced to the electors in advance. <Amended on December 9, 2020>

③ The question of whether to take an online voting shall be determined by the Election Management Committee. If the voting process is entrusted to the National Election Commission, the question of whether to take an online voting shall be determined by the Election Management Committee in consultation with the National Election Commission. <Amended on December 9, 2020, May 27, 2022, and March 25, 2025>

Article 37 (Witnessing Voting and Ballot Counting) ① The candidates shall select from among the electors two (2) or less persons to witness the voting process at the polling station and report it, in writing, to the Election Management Committee (National Election Commission) by two (2) days prior to the election day, and shall select another two (2) or less persons to witness the ballot counting and report it, in writing, to the Election Management Committee (National Election Commission) by the preceding day of the election. In this case, the ballot counting witness(es) can be also the voting witness(es), concurrently. <Amended on March 25, 2025>

② If the candidates fail to report their voting witness or ballot counting witness to the Committee, the candidates shall be considered to have waived the right to witness the voting and counting process.

③ In the cases where there is no selection of witnesses or the witnesses are selected only by one (1) candidate, the Election Management Committee (National Election Commission) shall select extra witnesses among fair and neutral people, to make

the total number of the witness be four (4), with the consent of the selected witnesses themselves. Those who are selected as the extra witness by the Committee shall submit the consent form to the Committee.

④ Candidates, candidates' spouses, or executives or employees of Kukkiwon cannot be the voting witness or ballot counting witness. <Amended on March 25, 2025>

⑤ Voting witness can be omitted in the case of online voting. <Newly inserted on May 27, 2022; Amended on August 18, 2022>

Article 38 (Objections to the Validity of Voting, etc.) ① Any candidate or electors who intends to raise objections to the validity of the election result shall submit an objection to the Election Management Committee, in writing, within five (5) days from the date when the grounds for objection occur (Election date if it concerns the validity of voting). <Amended on December 9, 2020, and August 18, 2022>

② The witnesses of ballot counting have the right to demand to cure any violation they notice in the ballot counting. <Amended on December 9, 2020>

Article 39 (Handling of Trust Money) ① The Election Management Committee (National Election Commission) shall return the trust money in full to the successful candidate, or the candidates who receive not less than 20/100 of the total valid votes, or the candidate who passes away, within thirty days from the election day. On the other hands, the trust money of the candidates who receive less than 20/100 of the total valid votes shall be vested in Kukkiwon, entirely. <Amended on May 27, 2022>

② The trust money of the candidates whose registration is nullified or who resign from the election shall be vested in Kukkiwon, instead of being returned to them.

Article 40 (Validity of Election, etc.) ① Deleted <May, 27. 2022>

② Deleted <December 9, 2020>

Article 41 (Payment of Daily Expenses, etc.) Kukkiwon has the right to pay the voting witnesses and ballot counting witnesses daily service expenses and food expenses, etc. <Amended on May 27, 2022>

Chapter 6. Decision of the Elected <Amended on March 25, 2025>

Article 42 (Decision of the Elected) ① Decision of the successful candidate, or the elected, shall follow each of the following subparagraph. <Amended on December 12, 2020, and May 27, 2022>

1. A candidate who receives the majority of valid votes;

2. In the case of a tie among two or more candidates receiving the highest number of votes, the candidate who has the higher Dan in Taekwondo; and
 3. In the case where the candidates have the same Taekwondo Dan in Subparagraph 2, the one who has the earlier date of Dan certification.
- ② If there is only one (1) candidate registered after the closing of the candidate registration, or a candidate who has registered dies, or only one (1) candidate is left due to the nullification of registration, the candidate who receives the majority agreement of the valid votes of the electors shall be determined as the elected. <Amended on December 9, 2020, and May 27, 2022>
- ③ The Election Management Committee shall issue the election certificate to the successful candidate once the president elected is determined **【Form 15】**.

Article 43 (Nullification or Invalidity of the Election) If it is found that the elected for Kukkiwon President has a ground for disqualification in accordance with the Articles of Association, the validity of his or her election shall be nullified. <Amended on March 25, 2025>

Article 44 (Announcement of Successful Candidate for President) Once the successful candidate for the President is determined, the Election Management Committee shall announce the name of the elected on the Kukkiwon website, immediately using the **【Form 16】**. <Amended on August 18, 2022, and March 25, 2025>
[Title amended on March 25, 2025]

Chapter 7. Supplementary Provisions

Article 45 (Re-Election) ① In any of the following cases of subparagraphs, re-election shall be conducted.

1. In the case where no candidate is registered. <Amended on May 27, 2022>;
2. In the case where the Election Management Committee (National Election Commission) decides to nullify either the election process or the successful candidate from the election;
3. Deleted; or
4. In the case where the successful candidate, or the elected, resigns or dies before he or she begins the term of the President.

② If the Election Management Committee (National Election Commission) decides to nullify the election as prescribed in Paragraph 1 Subparagraph 2, it shall return the trust money to relevant candidate. Provided, however, that the direct reason for the decision of nullification is attributed to a certain candidate him/herself, his

or her trust money will not be returned.

Article 46 (By-Election) Deleted <March 25, 2025>

Article 47 (Measure against Violation) The Election Management Committee (National Election Commission) has the right to take necessary action to stop, warn, order to correct, or investigate the election process in accordance with Articles 72 and 73 of the Act on Elections Entrusted by Public Organizations.

Article 48 (Protection of Election Crime Reporters) No person shall inform, disclose, or publicly report the personal information of a person reporting the violation in the election process or any other information that enables third parties to identify the reporter.

Article 49 (Other Matters) Matters not prescribed in the Articles of Association or these Regulations in relation to the president election shall be determined by the resolution of the Election Management Committee. However, in the case that the president election is entrusted to the National Election Commission, such matters shall be determined in consultation between the Election Management Committee and the National Election Commission.

Article 50 (Language and Interpretation) ① The documents relating to the president election under these Regulations (including video images) can be made in either Korean or English. <Newly inserted on August 18, 2022>

② If the original texts of these Regulations and/or other related documents (including video images) made in Korean conflict with their corresponding English versions or in the case of discrepancy in interpretation between the Korean and the English versions, the original Korean versions shall prevail. <Amended on August 18, 2022>

Article 51 (Amendment) The amendment to these Regulations shall be approved by the Board of Directors.

[Title amended on April 30, 2025]

Addendum <Enacted on July 19, 2019>

Article 1 (Enforcement Date) These Regulations shall take effect on the day of resolution by the Board of Directors.

Article 2 (Transitional Measures) ① Despite these Regulations, the first president election under these Regulations may be governed by separate regulations resolved by the Board of Directors for matters such as the period of constituting the Election Management Committee, election schedule, and various dates for decision. Furthermore, the period of resignation (withdrawal) application prescribed in Article 18 Paragraph 3 shall be ten (10) days from the next day of the appointment of the members of the Election Management Committee.

② The day when the reasons to enforce the first president election are confirmed shall be the day when the members of the Election Management Committee are appointed pursuant to Article 5 Paragraph 3 of these Regulations.

③ The term of the elected President in the first president election shall start anew and begin from the date when the elected is announced by the Committee.

Article 3 (Prohibition of Concurrent Position) The members of the Election Management Committee shall not take the position of the members of the Director Recommendation Committee, concurrently.

Article 1 (Enforcement Date) These Regulations shall take effect on the day when the Articles of Association resolved by the Board of Directors are approved by the Minister of Culture, Sports and Tourism.

Article 2 (Transitional Measures on the Confirmation Date of the Reason for Enforcement) The enforcement date in Article 1 of this Addendum shall be applied only if the president election is held based on the reasons prescribed in August 18, 2020.
