Regulations on the President of kukkiwon

ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION OF KUKKIWON

Article 10 (Election of President) ① The President shall hold the 6th Dan or higher level at Kukkiwon Taekwondo and be elected by the electoral college for President and be reported to both the Board of Directors and the Minister of Culture, Sports and Tourism.

Article 12 (Grounds for Disqualification of Executives) ① Persons falling under any of the following subparagraphs shall not be an executive. <Amended on May 13, 2019, and July 24, 2019>

1. Persons falling under any of the subparagraphs of Article 33 of the State Public Officials Act;
2. Minors;
3. Persons who have committed crimes described in Articles 355 or 356 of the Criminal Act with respect to the performance of their duties during their tenure at a sports organization described in Article 2 Paragraph 9 Subparagraphs A through C of the National Sports Promotion Act, or an organization as a branch office, sub branch office, or sub-sub branch office of a specific sport, or World Taekwondo, and as a result, have been sentenced to a fine of not more than three million KRW and for whom five (5) years have not passed since the final decision of their punishment being rendered, or have been sentenced to a fine of not less than three million KRW with the final decision of their punishment being rendered;
4. Persons who have been subjected to a disciplinary action of not less than one (1) year of qualification suspension by a sports organization described in Article 2 Paragraph 9 Subparagraphs A through C of the National Sports Promotion Act, or an organization as a branch office, sub branch office, or sub-sub branch office of a specific sport, or World Taekwondo, but for whom five (5) years have not passed since the date of expiration of the disciplinary action (Provided, however, that a person has been subjected to a disciplinary action of not less than one (1) year of qualification suspension by a sports organization described in Article 2 Paragraph 9 Subparagraphs A through C of the National Sports Promotion Act, or any other organization related to a specific sport, or World Taekwondo because of their manipulation of game results, violence or sexual violence, embezzlement, breach of trust, or biased judgment, that person shall be banned from being elected as an executive);
5. Persons who have been dismissed or expelled by a sports organization described in Article 2 Paragraph 9 Subparagraphs A through C of the National Sports Promotion Act, or any other organization related to a specific sport, or World Taekwondo because of disciplinary

action applied to the persons or designation of their affiliated organization as an organization under special management due to their wrong-doings, such as manipulation of game results or abuse of their authority, or negligence at work;

6. Persons who have committed crimes described in Article 314 of the Criminal Act or Articles 47 or 48 of the National Sports Promotion Act as they engaged in the manipulation of game results affecting the results of matches hosted by a sports organization described in Article 2 Paragraph 9 Subparagraphs A through C of the National Sports Promotion Act, or any other organization related to a specific sport, or World Taekwondo and, as a result, have been sentenced to a punishment not less than a fine with the final decision of such punishment being rendered;

7. Persons who have been sentenced to a punishment not less than a fine for driving while intoxicated;

8. Persons who have been subjected to a disciplinary action of not less than the suspension of qualification in relation to the evaluation of Poom and Dan Promotion Tests of Kukkiwon; or

9. Members of the National Assembly, the head of a local government, or local council members.

② Any executive who falls under any of the subparagraphs in paragraph 1 above or is revealed to fall under any of such categories at the time of his or her appointment as an executive, the executive shall resign from the position, as a matter of course.

③ The effectiveness of paragraph 1 subparagraph 7 of the present article shall follows Article 7 of the Act on the Lapse of Criminal Sentences. <Newly inserted on July 24, 2019>

④ Persons appointed (or elected) or expected to be appointed (or elected) as executives shall cooperate in submitting required documents to verify the grounds for the disqualification of executives. If such persons fail to cooperate without a special reason, their appointment may be canceled by a resolution of the Board of Directors (or the Chairman).

President Election Management Regulations

Article 18 (Eligibility) ① Candidates for President shall be a high-ranking Taekwondo athlete, having not less than 6th Dan of Kukkiwon Taekwondo as of the opening date of candidate registration pursuant to Article 10 Paragraph 1 of the Articles of Association. <Amended on December 9, 2020, August 18, 2022 and March 25, 2025>

② As of the opening date of candidate registration, any person who falls under the disqualification grounds in Article 12 of the Articles of Association of Kukkiwon cannot be the candidate. <Amended on December 9, 2020, August 18, 2022 and March 25, 2025>

③ If an executive or employee of Kukkiwon, World Taekwondo, Korea Taekwondo Association, Taekwondo Promotion Foundation, Taekwondo 9th Dan Association, Korea Taekwondo Association

for the Disabled, Korea Women Taekwondo Federation and any affiliated entities thereof intends to register as a candidate, he or she shall resign (withdraw) from relevant organization not later than 90 days before the expiration of the term of the President. Provided, however, that such persons are registered as a candidate for the election which is held because of the vacancy or inability of the presidential office, they shall resign (withdraw) from relevant organization within ten (10) days from the day when the grounds for election are confirmed, unless the establishment of the Election Management Committee is delayed due to special circumstances such as natural disasters or an influx of infectious diseases. In the later case, the prospective candidates shall resign (withdraw) from relevant organization within ten (10) days from the date designated by the Election Management Committee. <Amended on December 9, 2020, May 27, 2022, and March 25, 2025>

④ In the case where the incumbent Chairman of Kukkiwon resigns in order to register him/herself as a candidate for President, the president election in such case will be deemed to be held due to the expiration of the presidential term. <Newly inserted on August 18, 2022>
